TSCA STATEMENT

To our Valued Customers:

The Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), administered by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) addresses the production, importation, use, and disposal of specific chemicals. Six chemical substances receive special attention under TSCA: PCBs, asbestos, radon, lead, mercury, and formaldehyde.

Under TSCA section 6(h), EPA identified the following five persistent, bioaccumulative and toxic (PBT) chemicals to address risk and reduce exposures to the extent practicable and published final rules for:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE; CAS 1163-19-5)
- o Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1); CAS 68937-41-7)
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP; CAS 732-26-3)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD; CAS 87-68-3)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP; CAS 133-49-3))

These chemicals build up, or accumulate, in the environment over time and can therefore have potential risks for exposed populations.

In December 2024, the EPA updated regulations concerning chemical substances significant new uses.

Hereupon, we would hereby like to confirm that all steel articles delivered by Böllinghaus Steel Lda. do not contain any of the above mention substances nor none of the substances under EPA's current risk management activities.
